



<u>Order Processing on GeM:</u> Field officials are receiving material and submitting acceptance of PRC (Proof of Receipt Certificate) and CRAC (Consignee Receipt and Acceptance) in GeM. Various stages involved during this processing are shown in form of flow chart:



It is also observed that consignees are not aware of the correct processing of invoice/bill received in GeM due to which mistakes are done. This may delay the bill payment resulting into interest payment to the firms. Following check list has been prepared to ensure checking of all the items before processing PRC and CRAC on GeM.
