Though prices of vegetables under rising temperature are under check at wholesale market Cotton Market and in Kalamna Market, yet at retail bazaar, the prices of vegetables continue to command double the prices.

Similarly, due to high temperature, the vegetables have lost their quality and most of them are tasting a bit tangy.

This has scuttled the budget of many households.

The situation is likely to improve only after onset of monsoon when arrivals in the market improve and prices dip.

The only succour that the housewives have got is that no marriages would take place in May, thus preventing further rise in the prices of vegetables due to more demand.
